Assessment Report

The C/N has been in the Lower Mainland area on a sporadic basis since October 1980, having arrived at that time from the Ottawa area where he had acted as an [redacted] in a soft drug operation. He was coded at that point as [redacted] During January of 1981 he successfully assisted [redacted] in a similar role; reports from both locations are being forwarded to "E" Div.1 Intell. & Undercover Ops (Drugs). Amounts of past payments are not known to the writer."

The source is presently renting at the Patricia Hotel in Vancouver and is attempting to locate an apartment here. He is employed as an [redacted] and intends to remain in the area. He has provided the writer with intelligence regarding the owners and operators of a local night club and a cocaine dealer (ounce level) in Campbell River, B.C. Independent investigation has confirmed the information,

His criminal record includes convictions of fraud, possession of stolen property and possession of narcotics (hashish). He is on probation until August 1982 with reference to the fraud conviction from Gatineau, Quebec. The conditions of probation are unknown at this time, but have been requested. He is also presently wanted in Gatineau on what appears to be a provincial statute involving insurance. It is a 1978 charge with a returnable radius of 60 kilometers.

It is the writer's intention to utilize the source in an intelligence capacity with particular reference to the financial background and criminal activities of businesses and individuals of interest to this Section. I feel he has the potential to function at this level.

His identity is known to Sgt. INGENTHORN and Sgt. BOWER of this Section.
