Dear Minister,

I was recently contacted by Mr. Alain Olivier, regarding his experience, as covered by CTV's W5 program, "Mistaken Identity," and the actions of the RCMP.

To understand the scope of Mr. Olivier's experience at the hands of undercover officers, with the RCMP, in Operation Deception, is quite shocking. As you know, Mr. Olivier spent eight years in a Thai prison, before being transferred to Canada. Mr. Olivier has written to you, asking for a public inquiry under Section 24(1) of the RCMP Act. I believe he has numerous grounds for such an inquiry, not the least of which is the years of stonewalling and denial of justice that he has endured.

We can only have hope that the system of justice works, and that the pleas of this man do not fall on deaf ears. I respectfully ask that his case for an inquiry be properly considered and reviewed.
