Late in the afternoon of April 26, 1991, I spoke with Ms. Clare Beckton with respect to the proposed interview of Assistant Commissioner Frank Palmer regarding his participation in the Thailand case. I confirmed to Ms. Beckton that the Commission wants to interview Assistant Commissioner Palmer as soon as possible and that Tuesday, April 30, appears to be satisfactory. I told Ms. Beckton that you would telephone her on Monday, April 29, to finalize the arrangements. She has suggested that the interview take place in the late afternoon in the Legal Services boardroom at RCMP Headquarters in Ottawa.

I spoke with the Chairman and suggested that I be replaced for this interview by another member of the staff in view of my relationship with Assistant Commissioner Palmer. The Chairman has named our General Counsel to accompany you for the interview.

I asked Miss Beckton about your request for a copy of a report that Assistant Commissioner Palmer would have submitted in relation to this case and she replied that the report in question is an internal document not relevant to the complaints and that the Force has decided not to acquiesce to the request.
