The Thailand Case

Using the draft report of November 19, 1991, that you prepared, I have examined the report and made substantial changes to it. The Acting Chairman has asked me to send you a copy to read and for discussion with you either tomorrow, December 18, or on the 19th. Changes or additions have been made in bold letters. However, there are a number of paragraphs which were removed. I have expressed the view to the Acting Chairman that we should send the report out before the end of December 1991. Therefore, I feel it is urgent that we get together to finalize our submission.

I have classified the report "Protected" until we agree to its declassification. To assist us in making our decision, I suggest that the Force should be invited to read the first eleven chapters and submit their recommendations. I have not spoken with the RCMP but I believe they would assign a member immediately to do so.

I am also enclosing possible additional findings that could be part of the report. It seems to me that they contribute to the description of who Olivier is.

Furthermore, I have read again a number of documents that form part of the investigation. I have found that Olivier has an FPS number and he may therefore have a criminal record. Fingerprints have been requested from Thailand. I should obtain the information in the next two or three days.


Also, in Superintendent Pouliot's statement, Paul McEwen has recorded the following:

Amaresreth took his men to Chaing Mai to avoid the "corruption factor." Re: an agreement established in 1972 between the Force and the MNU re working together.

I am obtaining a copy of this agreement, if it really exists.

These two items have obviously been overlooked and, depending on their content, we may have to take them into consideration.
