722 Q- M'hm.

A- What's the other one? Oh, Thailand dealt with multi kilos of heroin as well.

723 Q- M'hm. All right. And just to take us back to the incident where Mr. Flanagan was involved in an accident on February nineteenth (19th), nineteen eighty-nine (1989). What was your involvement once you had been informed that he had been involved in an accident?

A- When I was informed I... I called Ottawa and advised them what had happened. I was in contact with the Embassy. And I got a hold of General Bamroong. And arrangements were made for me to go over... to go back up to Chiang Mai and assess the situation and to participate in any... anything that I could console the members involved in the situation.

724 Q- M'hm. And with respect to Mr. Flanagan?

A- Mr. Flanagan, I... I attended the autopsy in Chiang Mai Hospital... University Hospital. And examined the body where no... no marks of violence were noted or found. He had died of a... as a result of falling on his head and splitting his head open, he died of respiratory conditions due to the brain... I can't give you the exact wording, but if you have

it handy.

725 Q- I did.

A- I have it here.

726 Q- M'hm.

A- "Internal exam showed marked vein
oedema and thin subdural haemorrhage
at bi-frontal and bi-(inaudible)
lobes. Multiple skull fractures at
left occipital bone and forearm
magnum."

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727 Q- Just one sec. I will refer you...

A- All this to tell you that he died of respiratory
failure.

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A- Okay. On page 15 of my notebook...

728 Q- Yes.

A- ... the bottom, it says that:

"Compressed..."

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After going through all that wording on page 14, but
on page 15...

729 Q- Yes, you don't need to read it. It's page 21. And
the autopsy is D-1, Tab 6, page 918. Is that the
document that would have been provided to you?

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A- That's correct.

730 Q- Yes. And just to complete. Mr. Pouliot does have
a CV which we'd like to produce. D-61.
