Sir

In light of what occurred at my trial and in order to prevent it from taking place again, I, Alain Olivier, wish to file the following letter, as my official complaint against Justice Michel Caron, in the case # no 500-05-058936-004.

The learned Judge has greatly misused the power of his office, when he refused to order Defendants to produce their already discredited star witness, Mr. Jean-Marie Leblanc a.k.a. Glen Barry, now in hiding somewhere on the Canadian East Coast, after being told by the RCMP not to appear at trial, despite the subpoena prior issued to his attention.

The learned Judge also has showed a complete lack of integrity, when he refused to intervene or say a word, when all the evidence presented before him established without a doubt that Defendants were clearly and bluntly perjuring themselves before him. Not to mention that prior, the Defendants had been entirely untruthful in their answer to a Court Order issued by Justice Diane Marcelin March 31, 2005 and re-enforced thereafter by Justice De Grandpré with regard to my identity and when they, the RCMP had realised they had made a mistake.

The learned Judge has totally failed in his duty, when he wilfully neglected to apply the appropriate provisions of the Quebec and Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, which should have prevailed over political influences to which he obviously succumbed.

The learned Judge failed in his duty, to apply well-known law related to Entrapment and with regard to Prescription.

The learned Judge failed in his duty by omitting to apply the notions of Natural Justice to the evidence presented before him. The Judge simply disregarded the overwhelming evidence presented before him and made what can only be qualified as a political decision.

The learned Judge (voluntary or otherwise) demonstrated a level of incompetence that should not be left uncorrected. His presence on the bench represents a danger to the

integrity of the Court and our Judicial System. Not to mention the further danger to other Canadian Citizens, whom like I did, are seeking justice and who could eventually end up before him in other civil cases against the RCMP and the Attorney General of Canada.

The learned Judge intentionally failed in his duty, perhaps due to all the Political influences surrounding this case, which were equal to what was politically at stake, when he failed to abide to the rule of Law and the Judge's Code of Ethics. The Code of Ethics clearly stipulates and provides that a Judge must consider all the evidence presented before him, in an appropriate, just and reasonable manner. He failed to do this in the present case and disregarded the obvious, in order to reach conclusions that were not at all supported by the evidence adduced before him or that were entirely at odds with said evidences and thereby breaching the rules of Natural Justice. Was it done deliberately and/or by fear of reprisals?

The learned Judge has evidently failed in his duty, when he decided to go forward with a four months trial and this, when his mind had already been made up from the start that my case was prescribed.

The learned Judge by doing so, has knowingly allowed taxpayers money to be needlessly spent and wasted, not to mention of making a mockery of the thousands of hours of work performed by myself and the team of my Attorneys working pro-bono on my case for the last five years.

The learned Judge as evidently failed in his duty, and has acted contrary to his Code of Ethic, by willingly ignoring and disregarding the vast majority of the evidence adduced before him during forty days of trial. That by doing so, the learned Judge, as well as the Attorney General of Canada have knowingly and wilfully brought the Administration of Justice into disrepute.

Thank you for your time and concerns for the truth and the integrity of our Judicial and Judiciary system. I remain...
