At that time, when Corporal Flanagan is in the back of the truck with the Thai, it's at that time that he produces his package, which Corporal Flanagan advised me, "It's here," referring to the

drugs. "Let's do it." At which time we begin the take-down.

I yell "Police", and I had also earlier indicated for Sergeant Girdlestone to come moving in. And I had given a hand signal, I forget what it was because we also had a... a way to advise the cover team that we were going to do the take-down. And that's what takes place, we are now in the take-down process.

That's where Mr. Flanagan ends up struggling with the Thai male in the back, the female, Nipa, gets on the back of Corporal Flanagan, at which time I remove the female and restrain her. It's also during this time that Mr. Olivier is somewhere up front of the vehicle, begins to run towards where Sergeant Girdlestone is. He is restrained by Corporal Girdlestone.

The Thai police are now coming on scene. They take possession, or... take control of the two (2) parties, and I believe I actually used one of the Thai policeman's handcuffs to handcuff Nipa, and it's at that time then Mr. Girdlestone is advised somebody has fallen off the truck, and we go down the lane to find Corporal Flanagan.
