Re: Letter to your attention dated February 9, 2015-03-25

Mr Minister

Thank you for your late reply to my registered letter dated February 9, 2015 to your attention; unfortunately it missed answering crucial points.

Hereby, I am kindly asking you setting aside the bill for court cost imposed to me in; Alain Olivier vs. Attorney General of Canada et als SCM-500-05-058936-004 / CA-500-09-018408-088 / SCC-35284.

As Minister of Justice you do have the discretionary power cancelling the aforementioned bill or to make recommendation to the Governor in Council to order remission of pecuniary penalties such as court cost; which under the present situation would be the proper thing to do.

After being subjected to torture and the death sentence as a direct result of Canadian police actions, not to mention my years of incarceration in a third world country, and the Canadian Lower Courts concluding the prescription applied in my legal action, while closing their eyes on RCMP member's perjuries into the death of RCMP Cpl. Derek Flanagan, demanding me paying for court cost is not only abusive, but outrageous under the circumstances.

Being physically incapacitated for life resulting from a hit and run accident and financially destitute with a rent of less than \$500 monthly to live on, and court costs to the amount of \$496,461.31, someone lacked comprehension along the line. And not surprisingly, they are the same people who have closed their eyes on all the lies surrounding RCMP Derek Flanagan's death.
